**Why am I receiving this notice?** A class action settlement in the case styled *Rivera et al. v. Essen Medical Associates, P.C.*, Index No. 801239/2024E in the Supreme Court of the State of New York, Bronx County has been reached (the “Litigation”). The Litigation arises out of Plaintiffs’ claims against Essen Medical Associates, P.C. (“Essen” or “Defendant”) related to the unauthorized access to Essen’s data environment which occurred between March 14, 2023, and March 22, 2023 (the “Incident”). You are receiving this notice because Essen records show that your personally identifiable information (“PII”) and private health information (“PHI”) were potentially compromised as a result of the Incident.

**Who’s Included in the Settlement Class?** All persons who are residents of the United States whose Personal Information was potentially compromised in the Incident and received notice that their Personal Information may have been compromised in the Incident.

**What are the Settlement terms?** The Settlement provides to the Settlement Class Members who submit a valid claim for one or both of the following benefits: (1) a reimbursement of up to five thousand dollars (\$5,000) for unreimbursed costs, expenses, or charges incurred addressing or remedying identity theft, fraud, or misuse of Personal Information and/or other issues reasonably traceable to the Incident (“Documented Out-of-Pocket Losses”); and/or (2) a pro rata Cash Fund Payment of up to one hundred dollars (\$100). The exact amount of the Cash Fund Payment will depend on the number of participating Class Members. The deadline to submit a Claim Form is **June 1, 2026**.

**What are my other options?** If you **stay in** the Settlement Class, you will be legally bound by the Settlement’s terms and you will release your claims against Essen, regardless of whether you file a claim. If you do not want to be legally bound by the Settlement, you must **opt out** of the Settlement by **May 4, 2026**. If you opt out, you will not be entitled to any relief, but you will retain the ability to file your own claim against Essen. If you do not opt out, you may **object** to the Settlement by **May 4, 2026**. The Long-Form Notice available on the Settlement Website explains how to opt out or object.

**The Court’s Fairness Hearing.** The Court will hold a Fairness Hearing on **July 7, 2026**, to consider whether to approve the Settlement and a request for \$1,333,333.33 in attorneys’ fees, plus expenses for plaintiff’s counsel, and \$3,000 Service Awards for each Class Representative. You may appear at the hearing, either yourself or through an attorney hired by you, but you don’t have to appear. For more information, visit the Settlement Website.
